Autism Spectrum

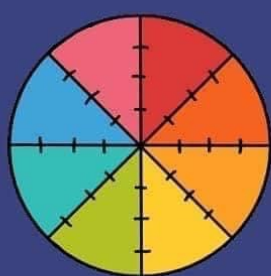
The Autism Spectrum is **NOT** linear

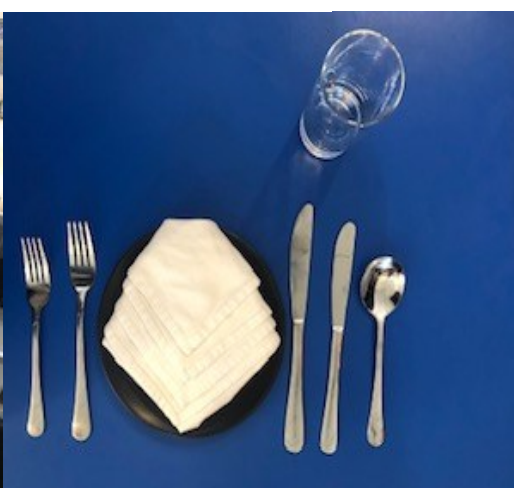

Phonics











refers to explicit instruction in sound-letter correspondence and in using sound-letter correspondences to decode or pronounce words in text.



Phonemic Awareness

is not about how sounds correspond to letters; it is only about hearing, thinking about, and manipulating the spoken sounds within words.
